CLEMATIS PRUNING GROUP

Group One: This group blooms only on wood grown the previous season then ripened in Autumn. Pruning should be done immediately after flowering. Includes all small flowered varieties and Evergreens.

Group Two: Large flowered types which bloom on previous seasons' ripened stems. To prune, remove weak and dead stems and make corrective pruning in summer when needed.

Group Three: All types which produce flower on new wood. To prune, do a February cleanup on this group, cutting stems back down close to ground where a strong axil bud occurs, hopefully just above the previous years' cut.
